Your Learning Journey

When you enrol onto one of our **flexible online courses** you will work through a range of learning materials, whilst being supported by one of our tutors, to build on existing knowledge and learn new skills. These online courses are non-accredited and have no pre entry requirements, unless stated otherwise and are suitable for those aged 19 or over.



Our **live stream online courses** have a live video session. You will need to be able to attend the video sessions at the set day and time every week.



Our face to face courses are delivered at our venues across the county and you will need to be able to attend every session. Sessions will be delivered in line with government guidance in a Covid safe environment. There will be a maximum number allowed to attend the venue. Your course will be planned to be delivered face to face but some of your course may need to be delivered remotely, depending on local and national Covid-19 advice. Your tutor will support you with the skills and knowledge that you may need to access remote learning.



Your Learning Journey



The recommended learning hours for most of our flexible online courses is 10 hours in total. The courses are flexible, meaning you can log on and complete your learning when it suits you. We will agree your expected end date together depending on the hours you can commit to learning per week. Live steam online and face to face courses have a weekly session for a set number of weeks. Please refer to the information given in this brochure or speak to the customer service team.

All of the learning for our online courses is delivered over an interactive learning portal. Therefore, you will need access to the internet via a laptop, desktop PC or tablet. Our online courses involve interactive learning through quizzes, videos and other resources. In face to face courses you will take part in a variety of activities. You will work alone, in pairs or in a group. There will be a variety of ways of learning such as practical activities, watching videos or using a computer which will help you meet the aims.

For both face to face and online learning you will have a tutor, who will be on hand to answer any questions. For non-accredited courses you will be assessed by your tutor in a variety of ways and they will provide you with feedback. Accredited courses will be assessed according to the requirements of the awarding body — either through a final assessment or through a portfolio of work. Your tutor will talk you through this at the start of your course.


